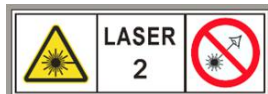

Do not disassemble

Do not attempt to disassemble or alter any part of the equipment that is not expressly described this guide.

Stop operating immediately if it emits smoke or noxious fumes

Failure to do so may result in fire or electrical shock. Immediately turn the IR camera's power off, Unplug the power cord from the power outlet. Confirm that smoke and fume emissions have ceased.

Stop operating immediately if it is dropped or the casing is damaged

Failure to do so may result in fire or electrical shock. Immediately turn the IR camera's power off, Unplug the power cord from the power outlet.

Prevent Malfunction

Avoid damaging the detector of the IR camera

Warning: Do not aim the IR camera directly into the sun or at other intense heat source which could damage the detector of the IR camera.

Avoid Condensation Related Problems

Moving the IR camera rapidly between hot and cold temperatures may cause condensation (water droplets) on its external and internal surfaces.

You can avoid this by placing the IR camera in the plastic safety case provided and letting it adjust to temperature changes slowly before removing it from the case.

If Condensation Forms Inside the IR Camera

Stop using the camera immediately if you detect condensation. Further use may damage the IR camera. Remove the memory card, (if applicable) and unplug power source, from the IR camera and wait until moisture evaporates completely before resuming use.

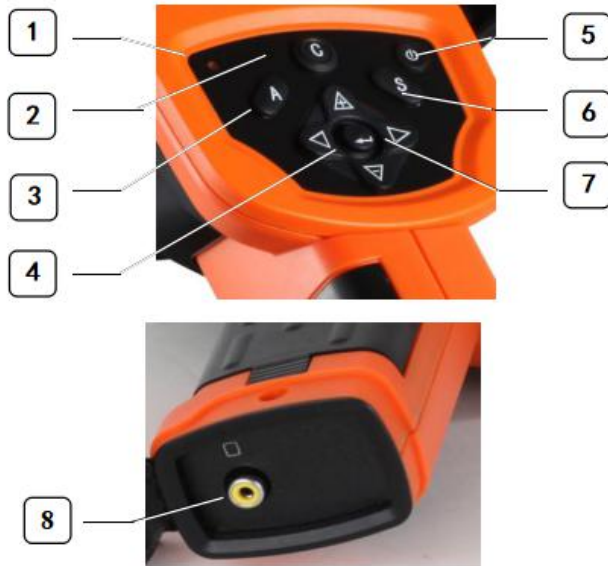

How to charge device

Method 1:

Put the battery into the battery charger.
Attach the power cord to the battery charger and plug into a power outlet.



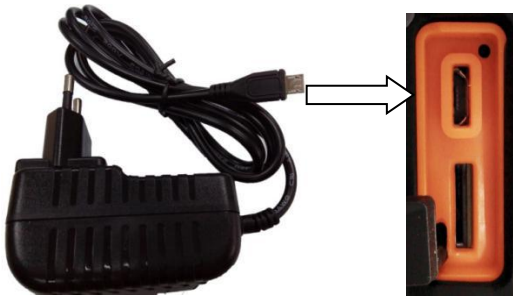
- The charge indicator light will turn red when the battery pack is charging. When

the battery is full, the charge indicator will turn blue.

- After charging, unplug the battery charger and remove the battery pack.

Method 2:

Install battery pack into the camera, you can charge the battery directly, by connecting the charger through the USB port



NOTE

1	This is a lithium ion battery pack so there is no need to discharge it completely before recharging. It can be recharged at any time. However, since the maximum number of charge cycle is approximately 300 (battery life), you are recommended to only charge the battery pack after having discharge it completely to prolong battery life.
2	Charging times will vary according to the surrounding temperature and battery pack charge state.

The camera comes with two to enter menus and operate the camera: Omni selector and touch screen.

Procedure

Here is two way to enter menus:








Omni selector:

1	Press the [C] key. The main menu will pop up.
2	Use the directional keys on the Omni selector to highlight the desired sub-menu icon and press [Enter] to enter navigate the menus.

Touch screen:






1	Touch the [SATIR] logo on the Main User Interface. The main menu will pop up.
2	You can use the touchscreen to navigate the menu by touching the desired sub-menu icon to enter that menu.

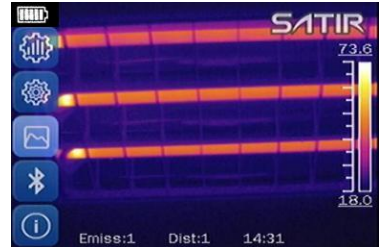

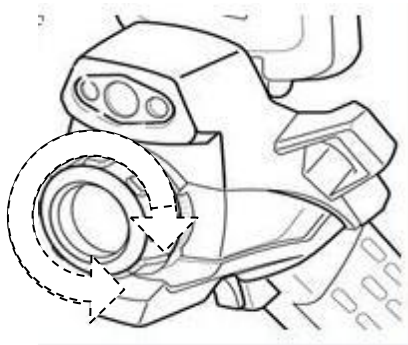

2	Turn the focus ring to focus on the target until the image is clear.

DIGITAL ZOOM

To use the Digital Zoom feature, ensure the camera is not in Focus Mode, and hold down the LEFT button and press Up or DOWN to zoom in and out respectively. "Zoom: xxx%" will appear in the middle of the left side the User Interface.

Display Mode

Thermal, Visual and DuoVision image display


This IR camera records visual images with its built-in digital camera. You can capture a visual image as a reference to the thermal image.

1 Press [C] button, or touch/select the **SATIR** logo.

2 Press the *DOWN* or *UP* arrow on the omni to selector to highlight  [Image] and press [OK] to enter the menu.

Alternatively, touch/select the [Image] menu icon to enter the menu.



3 If necessary, use the arrow buttons to highlight the  [Mode] menu icon and press [OK] to enter the menu.

Alternatively, touch/select the [Mode] menu icon to enter the menu.



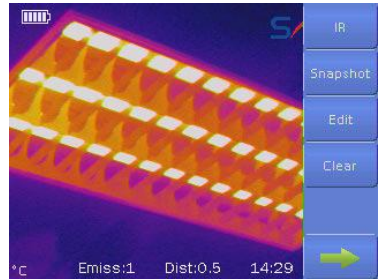

Use the arrow buttons or the touchscreen, navigate to desired image mode: IR, CCD, Merge, Merge Plus or Image Only.

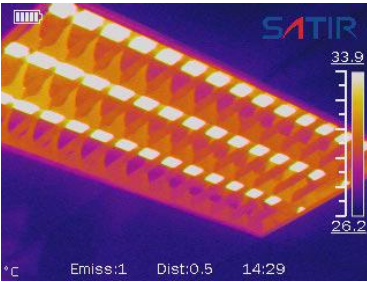

In DuoVision and DuoVisionPlus modes, you can merge the IR image and the visible image to create a more detailed image where text/signs is legible.



IR

In this mode, the IR information is displayed in the user defined pseudo color for easy analysis. Analysis tools can be used in this mode.



CCD

In this mode, you can see the image with full color. Analysis tools cannot be used while in this imaging mode.



Merge & Merge Plus

In these image modes, the background image is the visible image and IR image is centered onto the background merging the IR and visible images together.

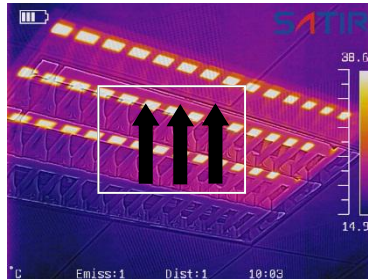
Merge Plus also outlines geometric shapes providing greater definition to the image.

Analysis tools can be used in this mode to analyze targets.



In either merge mode, the user can select the [Pos] function, this allows the user to align the IR and Visible images so they correspond correctly. To do this select [Pos] and using the touch screen move the image until both are aligned on the target.

About the IR/Visible settings

Percentage

Sets the ratio of IR images and Visual images. The value is from 1% to 100%. This is only available in Merge mode. Not Merge Plus.

Image adjustment

You can adjust the Level (brightness) and Span (contrast) of the image captured by IR camera, manually or automatically.

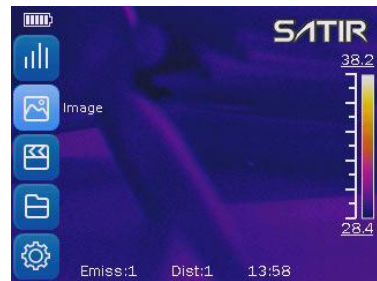

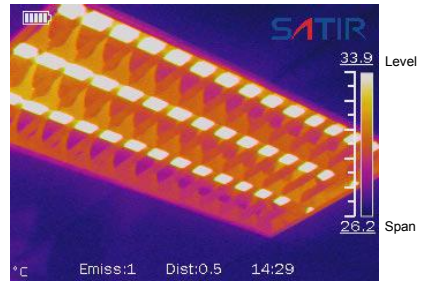

- 1 Set device adjust mode to Manual. How to set please refer to P35-36

- 2 The user can touch/select the values above or below the color bar to manually adjust the Level or Span values. Please see the figure to the right.



To adjust maximum temperature:

- 3
 - a. Tap the number above the color scale
 - b. Use the arrow buttons or touch screen, select the value of the Max Temp and touch/select [close] to finish the change.



To adjust minimum temperature:

- 4
 - a. Tap the number below the color scale
 - b. Use the arrow buttons or touch screen, select the value of the Min Temp and touch/select [close] to save it.

3. Is the built-in battery charged sufficiently?

•If the Problem Is Not Mentioned Above

If the USB Driver is not correctly installed, it is possible that Windows is not recognizing the USB Driver. Please contact your motherboard's manufacturer for the latest driver.

The USB2.0 real-time transmission function may not properly work under some model of motherboard's chipset. In this case, connect the IR camera to another computer which is based on the chipset of Intel configuration or Nvidia configuration and try again.
